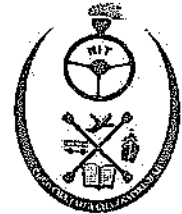

ADVERTISEMENT OF VACANCIES

21st MAY 2024

The National Institute of Transport (NIT) was established under the National Institute of Transport Act, No. 24 of 1982 cap 187 Revised Edition 2009 as an autonomous Higher Learning Institution. It is fully accredited by the National Council for Technical and Vocational Education and Training (NACTVET) with Registration number REG/EOS/009 of 2002. The Institute conducts training, research and consultancy in transport and related fields. Currently, the Institute is in the final stages of commencing pilot training in an effort to cater for the pilot demand overwhelming the air transport industry.

The Rector of the National Institute of Transport invites suitably qualified candidates to apply for two (2) vacancies mentioned below.

1.0 FLIGHT INSTRUCTOR I – (2 POSTS)

1.1 DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- (a) To prepare lessons for theoretical, simulator and flight exercises;
- (b) To conduct theoretical, simulator and flight training for student pilots;
- (c) To conduct briefing and debriefing for student pilots;
- (d) To assess theoretical and flying competence of the student pilots being instructed and submit recommendations;
- (e) To check student pilots for solo flights;
- (f) To prepare performance report for student pilots;
- (g) To conduct skill tests and proficiency checks for the issue of licences;
- (h) To develop and review curricula;
- (i) To plan, design, and review training programme;
- (j) To supervise flight instructors in all stages of training
- (k) To coordinate teaching activities and prepares learning resources;
- (l) To provide on the job training to junior staff;
- (m) To ascertain compliance with safety requirements at all times during training;
and
- (n) To perform any other related duties as may be assigned by the supervisor.

2.0 DIRECT ENTRY QUALIFICATIONS

The candidate should possess the following minimum qualifications:

- (a) Bachelor's degree in one of the following fields; Aircraft Engineering, Aeronautical Engineering, Aerospace Science, Aviation Engineering Management, Mechanical Engineering, Automobile Engineering, Electrical

- Engineering, Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering, Aviation Management, Air Transport Management, Airport Management, Airline Management, Aviation Safety Management, Logistics and Transport Management, Logistics Management, or Transport Management with a GPA of at least 3.5 or an average of at least B+ grade, from recognized institutions;
- (b) Valid Commercial Pilot Licence (Aeroplane) with Multi-Engine Instrument Rating and Grade III Flight Instructor Rating (Qualified Flight Instructor), issued by Tanzania Civil Aviation Authority;
 - (c) A total flight time of 1,000 hours of which a minimum of 250 hours must be logged as Certified/Qualified Flight Instructor, 500 hours as flight time on SEL/MEL, and 100 hours as PIC on Cessna 172.

OR

- (a) Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination with passess in Physics and Mathematics or Ordinary Certificate of Secondary Education Examination with passess in Physics, Mathematics, and English;
- (b) Valid Commercial Pilot Licence (Aeroplane) with Multi-Engine Instrument Rating and Grade III Flight Instructor Rating (Qualified Flight Instructor), issued by Tanzania Civil Aviation Authority;
- (c) A total flight time of 1,500 hours of which a mimimum of 250 hours must be logged as Certified/Qualified Flight Instructor, 750 hours as flight time on SEL/MEL, 250 hours as PIC on Cessna 172.

2.1 GENERAL CONDITIONS

- (a) The employment shall be on full time with one (1) year contract renewable;
- (b) All applicants must not be more than 60 years of age;
- (c) Applicants should apply on the strength of the information given in this advertisement;
- (d) For Tanzanian Citizens, applicants employed in the Public Service should route their application letters through their respective employers;
- (e) Applicants who have/were retired from the Public Service for whatever reason should not apply;
- (f) Certificates from foreign examination bodies for Ordinary or Advanced level education should be verified by The National Examination Council of Tanzania (NECTA) and National Council for Technical and Vocational Education and Training (NACTVET);
- (g) Certificates from Foreign Universities should be verified by The Tanzania Commission for Universities (TCU).

3.1 MODE OF APPLICATION

Interested candidates must submit a dully signed letter for consideration of the application attached with the followings:

- (a) An up-to-date endorsed Curriculum Vitae (CV) having two reputable referees and reliable postal addresses, e-mails and telephone numbers;
- (b) Two recent passport size photographs with blue background;
- (c) Certified copies of the following credentials:
 - (i) Bachelor's degree certificate and transcript (if any);
 - (ii) Form IV/Form VI National Examination Certificate(s);
 - (iii) Valid CPL(A) issued by Tanzania Civil Aviation Authority;
 - (iv) Birth certificate; and
 - (v) Passport.
